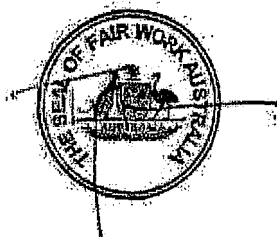

The voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is a collegiate electoral system. The electoral college will be comprised of all members of the ABI Council.
