I refer to the above election for your organisation.

RE: LODGEMENT OF PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR ELECTION

Australian Business Industrial (ABI) is a registered organisation under the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the FW (RO) Act), organisation code 143N. ABI is seeking to conduct an election in accordance with its Rules and the FW (RO) Act in the year commencing 1 January 2012.

Please accept the following information as lodgement of the prescribed information ABI is required to provide to Fair Work Australia (FWA) under s 189(1) of the FW (RO) Act and in accordance with regulation 138 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* (the regulations) to hold an election.

ABI is required to elect fifteen (15) offices of Councillor. These positions are due to expire in the normal course of events in conjunction with the term of the ABI Council.

ABI does not comprise branches and as such regulation 138(1)(d) does not apply.

In accordance with Rule 36 of the Rules of ABI, an eligible member of ABI may nominate for election to the Council by lodging his/her nomination with the Returning Officer in writing within three weeks of the publication of the election notice. ABI Council decided on 20 June 2012 that, subject to approval by FWA and the availability of the returning officer, the notice of election would be issued on 28 September 2012 and that the nominations would be closed on the 26 October 2012.

In accordance with Rule 35 of the Rules of ABI the roll of voters is to be closed seven days prior to the date for the opening of nominations. As such, the roll of voters is to be closed on 21 September 2012.
