Re: Request to appoint AEC to conduct election

I am the Sydney Branch Secretary of the Australian Institute of Marine and Power Engineers, and I am authorised under Rule 33B(ii) of the AIMPE Rules to make all necessary arrangements for the appointment of a Returning Officer to conduct elections for Sydney Branch positions. REASON FOR ELECTION:

The reason for the election being that the term of office of the Branch officials will expire on various dates in the second half of 2017:
President 15th December 2017;
Secretary 16th September 2017;
Treasurer 14th August 2017; and
Ordinary Members of Federal Council 14th August 2017.

A single combined election process will bring the election dates for all Sydney Branch elected positions back into alignment. All current members of the Branch Executive and Councillors have indicated to me that they are in agreement with this proposed course of action.

ELECTED BY:

The electorate for these elections are the financial members of the AIMPE Sydney Branch.

NOMINATIONS OPEN:

AEC Notice of the Election will need to be published in our union journal "On Watch" pursuant to Rule 33B (iii).

The relevant deadlines for On Watch notices are:

9th May 2017 &

6th June 2017

The respective On Watch editions would be in the members' letterboxes by:

29th May &

26th June.

Nominations could therefore open either on 30th June 2017 or 27th July 2017.

NOMINATIONS CLOSE:

Because we have a significant proportion of seagoing members, who are commonly away from home for up to 6 weeks, it is customary for the nominations to remain open for a period of up to 6 weeks. Accordingly Nominations should close no earlier than 11th August 2017 or 7th September 2017.

CUT OFF DATE FOR ROLL:

The same date as the close of Nominations, either 11th August 2017 or 7th September 2017.
