Further to your enquiry regarding the request for the holding of elections for the Northern Regional Chairman and the Vice Chairman for both the South and the North West Regions, I advise the following:

- o To be elected to these positions the candidate must be elected to their respective Regional Management Committees;
- o Regional Management Committee members are elected for two-year terms with half the committee members being elected annually. This amendment was approved last year, prior to the 2003/2004 elections being conducted;
- o Thus the elections for the Management Committees in 2003/2004 resulted in half the Committee Members being elected for two years the balance for a one-year term, thereafter the terms revert to two year terms;
- o The candidates elected to the subject executive positions were elected for a one-year term on their respective Management Committees. As such their term is due to expire;
- o Hence the request for the elections to be held.

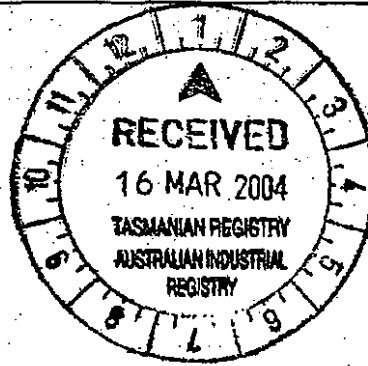

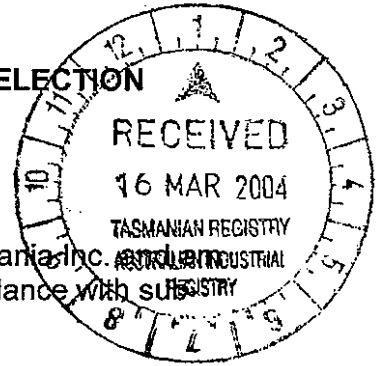
