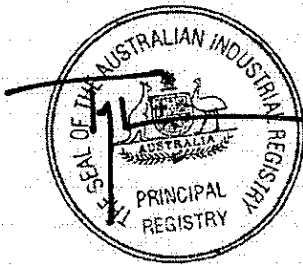
Arrangement for conduct of election.

The request is based on two issues, these being:

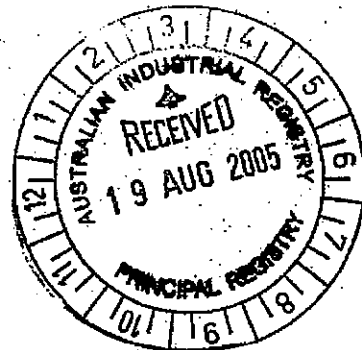

I have enclosed the prescribed, requisite information in accordance with Sub-Section 214(1) of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, relating to the above elections.

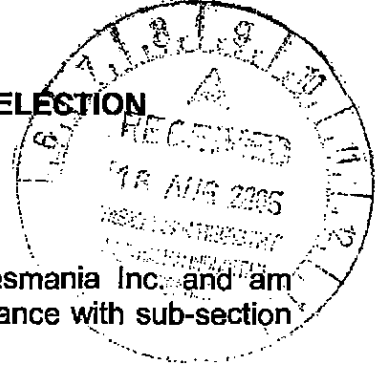
