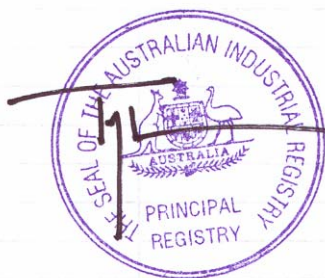

The whole of the financial ordinary membership and financial unemployed, casual, trainee and apprentice membership of the Union.


- 4 The dates and times for the nominations to open and close are:
