On behalf of The Victorian Showmen's Guild, I wish to lodge an application in respect of an **Election of Committee for 2010**.

The Offices positions are as follows: -

The term of office is for one year. The reason for the Election, being in accordance with the Rules of the Guild, to conduct an annual election. The persons are elected on a simple majority basis with members voting directly by mail.

Nominations are required to be called at least (56) days prior to the Annual General Meeting, which has been set down for 30 November 2010.

The date Nominations open is Friday, 23 July 2010.

Nominations close on Friday, 1 October 2010 at 12 noon which is not less than (42) days prior to the Annual General Meeting.

The Ballot opens on Friday, 15 October 2010 and the Ballot closes on Wednesday, 24 November 2010 at 9.00am.
