Rules specifying the method of lodgement of nominations were set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic would impact on the ability for potential candidates to nominate. Instead nominations were received electronically, via email/the AEC's portal.



1. I am authorised to sign this statement containing prescribed information for Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association (SA Branch).
2. The following information is lodged under subsection 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act).
3. This statement is updating the prescribed information in matter number E2020/3, which was submitted on the 24<sup>th</sup> of January 2020.
4. In relation to the Assistant Secretary and Committee of Management, the elections that are required are set out in the table in Annexure A.
5. In relation to the President and Vice-Presidents, the elections that are required are set out in the table in Annexure B.
6. Rule alterations impacting the election of Committee of Management members were approved by the Fair Work Commission on the 24<sup>th</sup> of February 2020. This applies to the electorates of the Committee of Management only.
7. The number of elected representatives on Committee of Management is calculated on a formula defined in the rules:
  - a. The rule number which specify the formula is 27.4:
  - b. The Committee of Management members represent four (4) electorates.
  - c. The formula is each electorate shall be represented on the Committee of Management by: one member for the first 2,500 members or part thereof as allocated to the electorate on the 31st March in the year of the election; and an extra member for each

subsequent 2,500 members, or part there of. Provided that the maximum number of representatives for an electorate on the Committee of Management will be three

- d. The information for calculating the formula is based on the number of eligible members in each electorate.
- e. The relevant date(s) for this information is 31 March 2020.
