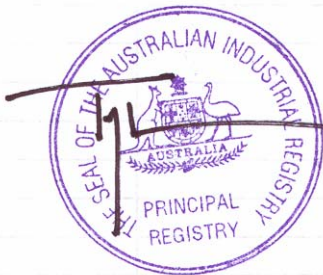
Arrangement for conduct of election.

On behalf of The Victorian Showmen's Guild, I wish to lodge an application in respect of an **Election of Committee for 2007.**

The term of office is for one year. The reason for the Election, being in accordance with the Rules of the Guild, to conduct an annual election. The persons are elected on a simple majority basis with members voting directly by mail.

Nominations are required to be called at least (56) days prior to the Annual General Meeting, which has been set down for 4 December 2007.

The date Nominations open is Friday, 27 July 2007.

Nominations close on Friday, 28 September 2007 at 12 noon which is not less than (42) days prior to the Annual General Meeting.

The Ballot opens on Friday, 12 October 2007 and the Ballot closes on Wednesday 21 November 2007 at 9.00am.
